

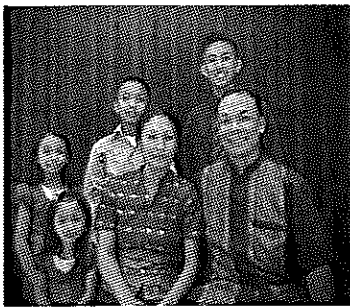

Dear friends and co-labourers in Christ,

March-May 2017

Greetings from Cambodia! We are thankful that we can share with you all what God has been doing the past few of months.

This past month, we held our first Family Conference. It was held in Kep, Cambodia, which is a small beach town along the coast, a few hours from Phnom Penh. Most of our church people from our various ministries were able to attend. In total, we had 175 people participate in the Family Conference. God blessed greatly and everyone had a wonderful time!

The Conference was a great time of preaching, teaching, fellowship, and activities. God used the preaching and teaching to touch many of our people's hearts, and many decisions were made. It was a blessing to see all of our church people— adults, married couples, singles, teenagers, and children, fellowshiping together in unity. We are thankful for all our people being a good testimony to the owner and employees of the guesthouse where we stayed at. They were wondering why we were having so much fun and that there were no arguments or fighting. Because this conference went so well, we plan to make it an annual occurrence.

One of the greatest blessings to come out of the conference was Srey Leak making a profession of faith during the conference. Her husband, Socheat, was saved a couple of months ago, and we had been praying that she will be converted also. We thank God for opening her heart and her receptiveness to the Gospel. Socheat and Srey Leak are from the Cham people group. As you may remember, from previous Updates, the Cham are Muslim. Socheat has been very faithful since he trusted Christ, and he has been attending Bible Institute every Monday. When Socheat first got saved, his father said that if his son truly changes from his previous ways, he will consider believing on Jesus also. **Please pray that this young couple will grow spiritually, and that God will use them to reach their family members with the Gospel.**

Another wonderful blessing from this conference was the protection of Man and Kanha. They are two of our national leaders here in Cambodia. It was a miracle that they were able to attend the conference because Kanha was nine months pregnant. They were able to participate the first three days, and on the fourth day, Kanha went into labour and their first child, Mary, was born. We praise God for this godly young couple. They are doing a tremendous job leading the work in Steung MeanChey! **Please keep Kanha and Mary in your prayers as they recover.**

We want to praise the Lord that Ngea accepted Jesus Christ as her Saviour a few weeks ago! Ngea is deaf and she has been attending our deaf ministry for over two years. We are thankful that God touched her heart and that she finally got saved. We appreciate Miss Grace's diligence in witnessing and building relationships with the deaf. **Please pray that many more deaf people will get saved, and that God will send me a young man to teach me Cambodian sign language so that I can properly communicate with the deaf here.**

On May 31st, myself and four other men are planning a survey trip to Preah Vihear province, which is four hours away. There is a family who lives in this province who are Christians, but they do not have a pastor who regularly teaches them the Bible. They have come to Phnom Penh a few times already to meet with us, and it seems like they are very hungry to be discipled from God's Word properly. The husband is Vietnamese and his wife is Khmer. The last time they came to visit us, they brought with them another Christian family who don't live far from where they do. The wife, Sökkim, is Kuy which is an ethnic minority group in Cambodia who have a distinct language and culture different from Khmer. **Please pray that God will show us His will in regards to this opportunity.**
