


Sadly, our second church in Ciudad Colón was forced to give up the building they have been renting for over 11 years. They have not been able to use the facilities there since the government shut down the churches in early March because of coronavirus. So many of the people have lost their jobs and are unable to work so they are also unable to tithe and give to missions; but the expense of rent and utilities still has to be paid. It finally became impossible to afford anymore. It was very sad news for me and for all of our people that the decision to let go of the building we started the church in over 11 years ago had to be made. We know that God knows all this and that He is ultimately in control of all of it and we believe that when the time is right, He will provide another place to meet as a church. Nevertheless, knowing all that doesn't make the decision any easier or any less painful. Until that time, thankfully, they are able to hold services, prayer meetings, devotions and Sunday school classes on line. We are praying that God will provide a place to buy or property to build a church building on. Please be in prayer for the Ciudad Colón church concerning this matter.

Please continue to pray for the Seminary. They began the 2nd semester of classes in July, all virtually via Zoom. How incredibly thankful are we for technology, right? It makes so many things possible.
